Projects:

- Changing the lawn to native shrubs and succulent plants, which are both low water usage plants.
 - Save gallons of water from eliminating grass.
 - Because of our major drought in California, it is important to conserve the limited water we have.
 - Inspire our student body about the environment by putting up plaques and signs elaborating on the reason why replacing grass is beneficial.
 - Make our school's campus more sustainable and add more texture to the landscape
- Fundraise for a few acres of land in California as a long term project

Regular Meetings:

 - Submit the forms for the fundraisers

 - Updates any activities or projects that the club does
 - Updates the calendars

Activities:

- Nature Walks
 - Mr. Rhyan, our adviser, will guide us through a walk during a meeting.
- River Cleanups
 - They are mainly on Saturdays with the American River Parkway Foundation
 - They vary in cleanup spots, depending on the event we go to
- School Cleanups
 - We can clean our school and help eliminate waste from getting into waterways
 - Make our school cleaner during meetings or outside of school hours, depending on what our club votes on.
- Have regular checklists consisting of sustainable activities
 - We will give a certain amount of time to try to achieve as many activities as possible, and whoever has the most will win a prize that is sustainable.

Fundraising:

- Recycling Drives
 - Create a presence in the community and educate people.
 - Recycle while fundraising
 - Allows recyclables, aluminum cans, plastic bottles, and glass bottles, to have a higher chance of getting recycled since we sort them out; only 9% is currently getting recycled.
 - We get the CA CRV back when we give it to the El Dorado Disposal.
- Selling Pura Vida Bracelets
 - We will choose a design as a club for the bracelet
 - Everyone is encouraged to sell the bracelets on their own, to family and friends, and there will be a leader board showing how many bracelets people have sold, the names will not be there.
